How to Interact with Minors on Campus:

Do

- Interact with students in a professional manner at <u>all times</u>
- Foster a mentor/mentee relationship
- Maintain appropriate boundaries
- Limit interactions with students to assisting with school events, activities, and functions

Do NOT

- Be alone, one-on-one with students
- Be present when students are changing clothes, uniforms, or costumes
- Interact with students on social media or socialize with students
- Touch students-unless relating to the following LIMITED circumstances and <u>only</u> <u>with</u> the permission of the student <u>AND</u> in the presence of event organizers:
 - o Spotting and/or assisting with positioning for circus, sports, or P.E.
 - Assisting with uniforms, costumes, or equipment
- Engage in any harassing or discriminatory behavior

How to Report Concerns:

If you become aware of inappropriate behavior involving a student or other minor, **report it IMMEDIATELY**

- In an emergency or when there is <u>immediate</u> risk of harm: Dial 9-1-1
- In a nonemergency:
 - o Notify event organizers who will contact DCFS
