

2020-2021 Thomas Metcalf School Health/Vision/Dental Exam Requirements & Other Medical Forms

Health Examinations: Students entering Preschool, Kindergarten, 6th grade, students entering school for the first time, and students transferring into Illinois from out-of-state, or out-of-country must submit a [DHS State of Illinois Certificate of Child Health Exam Form](#) with immunization history within 1 year of the first day of school (dated no earlier than August 14,2019). **Please fill out and sign the parent section of the health history.**

Immunization Requirements: [IDPH Immunization Requirements](#)

All students entering Kindergarten require:

- **DTP/DTaP - 4 or more doses** (last dose on or after 4th birthday)
- **Polio - 4 or more doses** (last dose on or after 4th birthday)
- **MMR (Measles, Mumps and Rubella) 2 doses**
- **Varicella (chicken pox) vaccine 2 doses**

All students K-12th grade require proof of:

- **MMR 2 doses**
- **Varicella 2 doses**

All 6th grade students require:

- **Hepatitis B** (series of three doses) most children receive the Hep B series as an infant.
- **Tdap 1 dose**
- **Meningococcal Conjugate Vaccine 1 dose** (on or after the 11th birthday)

*Please note that denying immunizations due to religious reasons has changed from previous years. You may contact the nurse if you have questions regarding this.

Vision Examinations: Students entering Kindergarten and students transferring into Illinois from out-of-state or out-of-country must submit a [Vision Exam Form](#) by October 15 of the current school year.

Dental Examinations: Students entering Kindergarten, 2nd grade, 6th, and 9th grade must submit a [Dental Exam Form](#) by May15 of the current school year.

If applicable, please print out the [Medication Authorization Form](#), [Food Allergy Action Plan](#), and/or [Asthma Management Plan](#), complete all fields, and submit to the school nurse.
